New and Emerging Artist Award Among Two Dozen Awards Totaling More Than \$22,000 for the 41st Montgomery Art Guild Museum Exhibition

The MMFA Junior Executive Board (JEB) will offer a new \$500 award for a first-time entrant in the Montgomery Art Guild Museum Exhibition. In addition to the JEB award there are seven other \$500 awards, three awards valued at \$715 each, eleven \$1,000 awards, one \$2,500 award, and the Nobel Seay Jones Best In Show Award of \$3,000. Awards will be announced at the opening reception on June 12 at 6:30 P.M. The exhibition will be on display through August 9.

The Montgomery Art Guild Museum exhibition is a juried show with a postmark deadline for entries on Saturday, April 4. The Call for Entries is posted on the websites of the Montgomery Art Guild (MAG) and the Museum. All adult artists are eligible to enter. The juror is Tom Butler, recently retired director of the Columbus (GA) Museum.

The featured artist this year is Clark Walker. A solo show of his paintings and drawings will be on display during the Montgomery Art Guild Museum exhibition.

The exhibition is organized by MAG and the Museum. JEB is the exhibition sponsor. Co-sponsors are Sterling Bank and Margaret Berry Lowder.
